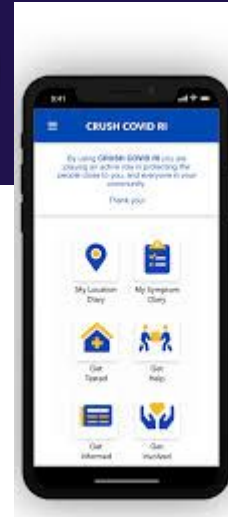

Health and Safety of Students and Staff: Daily Screening

- Daily COVID-19 Screening form all students and staff
- Parents/Staff complete screening each morning.
- Students and staff must stay home if they have symptoms
- Must quarantine if they test positive
- Staff confirms form has been completed and contacts families if not completed
- Families remind students to wear mask and social distance at bus stop.

Health and Safety of Students and Staff: Face Masks and Coverings, 6 Feet Distance, and Air Purification Systems

Students and staff required to wear masks on buses, entering schools, in hallways, in common areas, and in class.

Social Distancing and Desks 6 Feet Apart

All HVAC systems cleaned, updated, and Air Purifiers installed.

Vendor, ATC, has completed testing and air purifiers installed where needed to meet air exchange air exchange requirements (4-6 ACH).

Staffing Challenges

- **Increased positive cases of COVID-19.**
- **Number of close contacts of a confirmed case.**
- **Evolving Quarantine requirements (14 days, new guidance reduces this to 10 or 7 days with conditions. BWRSD will enact this guidance with voluntary testing students and staff beginning in January.)**

Staffing Challenges Continued:

- **Delay in notification from individuals or RIDOH that means more students and staff are potentially impacted.**
- **Domino effect: staff impacted by school closures in other districts.**
- **Close contacts during lunch.**

Week of Jan 11-15	Staggered schedule with secondary students returning no later than Jan 15.
Jan 18, 2021	Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday
