

ADMISSION OF NONRESIDENT STUDENTS

1. Application for nonresident attendance will be made to the School Committee through the superintendent, at whose discretion the student may attend school in the interim.
2. Tuition rates for nonresident students will be based on the per student cost as determined for the preceding school year. Tuition based on the previous year's per student cost may be charged on a pro-rated basis for any portion of the year in which a student has nonresidence status.
3. The School Committee will consider each application on its individual merits. The student must have a satisfactory disciplinary and academic record. Retention will be limited to the end of the school year in which the nonresidence occurs.
4. Under certain circumstances, the School Committee may waive payment of tuition.
5. A certificate of power of attorney or proof of legal guardianship must be provided to the office of the superintendent for all students classified as nonresidents.
