

HEALTH EDUCATION/PHYSICAL EDUCATION/TEACHING ABOUT
DRUGS, ALCOHOL, AND TOBACCO

Rhode Island law requires that children attending public schools be taught certain elements of physiology and hygiene, including the effects of alcohol, stimulants, and narcotics upon the human body; physical education; and accident prevention and health promotion.
