

NAMING OF SCHOOL DISTRICT FACILITIES

Policy of the School Committee in regard to naming school facilities is to follow current R.I. G. L. 45-2-16 Naming of city or town constructions. – Every city or town has the exclusive right, power, and authority to name any and all city or town sponsored projects, including, but not limited to, buildings, bridges, edifices, and any and all other construction or erection sponsored by the town or city and also including all projects constructed or erected pursuant to authority extended to municipal committees of city or town government, including, but not limited to, school committees or housing authorities. Each city and town may select committees through their representative councils for the purpose of determining the name to be selected.

The principles of good government would certainly encourage the Town Councils of the respective communities to work collaboratively with the Bristol Warren Regional School District committee in arriving at naming choices for facilities.
