BUDGET IMPLEMENTATION

State law requires that the School Committee operate the school system on a balanced budget; that is, encumbrances and accruals may not exceed the total revenue appropriated for the public schools in a given fiscal year.

The implementation of the school department budget will be the responsibility of the superintendent, who may delegate to the director of administration and others the task of administering certain parts of the budget implementation process. Oversight of budget implementation will be assigned to the Budget Subcommittee of the School Committee.

Any surplus funds in the regional will be used to support the next fiscal budget unless reappropriated.
