

SCHOOL COMMITTEE ELECTIONS

The School Committee shall consist of nine elected members. Each member town shall be represented in direct proportion to its population as determined by the most recent population census figures. To determine representation at the time of each biannual election, the total population of the district shall be divided by nine and the resulting quotients, rounded to the nearest whole number, shall be used as the basis for determining the proportionate representation of each member town.

At the general election in November, 1992 and at each general election thereafter, members shall be elected for a term of 4 years.

The members shall be elected on a nonpartisan basis. Each town shall elect its members on an at-large basis.
