SUPERINTENDENT'S CONTRACT/COMPENSATION AND BENEFITS

The appointment of a superintendent of schools is the responsibility of the School Committee, which alone has this authority under state law. Appointment requires a majority vote of the full Committee.

The employment of the superintendent will be secured by execution of a formal, written contract between the Committee and the superintendent. Under law, the maximum term of contracted employment is limited to three years from the date of issue.

The superintendent's compensation, benefits, professional opportunities, and consulting activities will all be subject to the terms of the current contract between the superintendent and the Committee.
